- **Acrylic Paints** (I use Liquid Liquitex or Golden paints). There are a couple of different sets of acrylic paint available. There also is a brand, “Reeves”, that has a good selection of colors and it’s inexpensive.
- One Liquitex large tube of white acrylic paint.
- One tube of Liquitex “Paynes Gray” acrylic paint.
- Paint Palette with “Lid” (Lid keep paints wet). I keep my palette in the refrigerator when I’m not painting.
- **Brushes:** There is a “Super Value Brush Pack by Artist’s Loft” inexpensive brushes with a large variety of sizes. “Craft Smart” large area flat brushes, 3 inexpensive brush in a pack.

Canvas Panels: 16” x 20”, and a small bottle of Gesso. I always put 2 coats of gesso on my canvas before painting. After I put the first coat, I lightly sand the surface before applying the 2nd coat, then sand again.

Mediums: (This is optional!!) I use “Liquitex” Glazing Medium and Matte Medium. I will talk about how I use these products in class.

Spray Bottle: (ACE Hardware has inexpensive spray bottles.)

White Artist Tape or masking tape.

Paper Towel

Graphite Paper: “Craftsmart” 18x24 (black); X-acto: knife/scissors; Ink pen; pencil; and a note pad if one wants to take notes.

NOTE: All these products can be found at Michaels. They are always offering a “40% and 50% Off One Item”. On a personal note, I haven’t paid full price for the large tube of white paint in many years. Why pay \$18,

when there are coupons available in their circulars or via the internet if you subscribe to Michaels website.
