Using a line drawing (think coloring book image), we'll make a dry point etching by scratching the surface of a plexi plate with a scribe, then inking with printing inks and printing using the printing press. We can also attach collage pieces in the printing process (Chine Colle') and/or add additional colors of brayered ink printed to your piece with a subtractive process using Q-tips. You can also paint the dry print with watercolors, colored pencils etc. to enhance.
